<u>Item 1</u> Garda report	Superintendent Jim Delaney Inspector Padraic Jones	Report given on both Longford and Granard areas. Some offences increased however others are decreasing. Road Traffic offence & Burglary's particularly for business and vehicles were on the rise, Gardai asked the public to be extra vigilant. Garda presence on the street has decreased slightly this is due to funding, a letter to be sent to the Commissioner to seek additional funding. Edgeworthstown was also discussed in regard to the Garda presence. Longford festival, HYPE and Street Soccer League were all a huge success.	
<u>Item 2</u> Local Authority	Ciaran Murphy	Clar approved 10 projects. Outdoor recreational scheme – waiting on funding. National Suicide Prevention Strategy group being set up. PPN highly represented on committee's throughout the county.	
<u>Item 3</u> Update on CCTV	Inspector Padraic Jones	Review completed in April some cameras are not up to standard. An application to update cameras and install one in the Oakvale area has been submitted to the Garda Commissioner. Cllr Peggy Nolan mentioned the cost of installing CCTV on community groups if it was the community representatives who sought CCTV and questioned if it was something the council and the JCP could fund if they identified a particular area in need of CCTV. Again it would come down to whether or not funding was available.	
<u>Item 4</u> Longford Joint Action Plan	Paddy Mahon	Ardnacassa is proposed to be the pilot area for the JAP. Agencies are on board to working individually and together with the Local Authority and the Gardai. It was discussed how local representatives were not invited to any of the meetings.
